**ORDER**

As per paper read (1) above University invited applications for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the Academic year 2020-21 from colleges for courses affiliated to the University. The Principals of Pharmacy Colleges mentioned in Para (6) below have submitted application and remitted required fee for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the year 2020-21 .

2. Applications were processed by the University and inspections were conducted in the Colleges.The reports submitted by the Inspection Commission were verified by the Scrutiny Committee.On verification it is reported that the colleges are having minor deficiencies The deficiencies pointed out by the Committee were intimated to the Colleges and the Colleges have furnished Compliance reports rectifying of deficiencies.

3. Governing Council vide decision read as (2) above has decided to grant Conditional Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the Pharmacy Colleges with minor deficiencies, mentioned in para (6) below for the Academic year 2020-21 based on the stipulations in the U.O.No.6296/AC-B/KUHS/2013 dated 28.11.2018 ( "that the affiliation shall be granted conditionally based on the compliance report submitted by the concerned college ")and on the condition that rectification of deficiencies shall be verified in the next years surprise inspection and if not found rectified, stringent action will be taken against the institution.

4. Governing Council vide decision read as (3) above also decided that AICTE approval is not mandatory for the grant of Provisional Affiliation/Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to Pharmacy Colleges based on the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India that Pharmacy Council of India is the authority to regulate Pharmacy education in India.

5. Now the Colleges have submitted renewal permission from PCI for the Academic Year 2020-

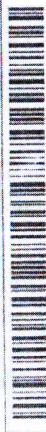

7. The Colleges shall strictly adhere to the general conditions detailed below:-

i) Selection, admission and collection of fees shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Govt. of Kerala and on the basis of the direction issued by the University from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will be cancelled.

ii) In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(c)56/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the College will be initiated.

iii) Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2020-21. The colleges have to apply for continuation of provisional affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex bodies concerned.

iv) The Colleges should remit annual administration fee fixed for UG/PG courses for the academic year 2020-21.

v) Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
