ORDER

1. As per the notification cited (1), University had invited applications for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2021-22 from colleges for courses affiliated to the University. Accordingly, the pharmacy colleges mentioned in Para (5) below have submitted the application and remitted required fee for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the year 2021-22.

2. Considering the situation due to covid19 pandemic, Governing Council vide decision cited (2), decided to give one time exemption to the colleges satisfying any of the following conditions, from inspection for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2021-22:

i. The colleges whose first batch of all courses are passed out and no major/minor deficiencies were pointed out during inspection conducted for the grant of continuation of provisional affiliation during the academic year 2019-20 and inspections were not conducted for the grant of continuation of provisional affiliation during 2020-21.

ii. The colleges whose first batch of all courses are passed out and no major deficiencies, but with minor deficiencies/nodeficiencies were pointed out during inspection conducted for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation during the academic year 2020-21.

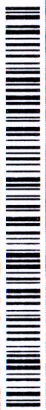
iii. The colleges which will satisfy any of the above two conditions, if exempting the norm that the first batch of the students of all courses admitted in the college under EWS quota in various UG, PG courses and /or under super speciality courses (starting/enhancement of seats) were passed out.

3. Based on the above, inspection was not required in the the pharmacy colleges mentioned in Para (5) below for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the year 2021-22. Accordingly, the 63rd Governing Council vide decision cited (3), decided to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to these Pharmacy colleges for conducting courses with annual intake mentioned against each, for the academic year 2021-22, subject to the receipt of renewal permission from PCI, without conducting inspection.

4. Now, these colleges have submitted renewal permission from PCI for the academic year 2021-22 and constituted

ii) In the light of the direction of the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(c)56/1998, the institution shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging, appropriate action including withdrawal of Affiliation of the College will be initiated.

iii) Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and is only for the academic year 2021-22. The college has to apply for continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing years remitting the fee fixed by the University, along with a copy of letter of approval from the apex body concerned.

iv) The Colleges except Govt. colleges shall remit Annual administration fee fixed for UG/PG courses for the academic year 2021-22.

v) Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.

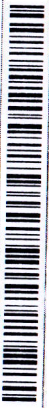

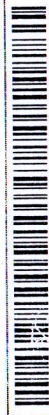

i. The colleges whose first batch of all courses are passed out and no major/minor deficiencies were pointed out during inspection conducted for the grant of continuation of provisional affiliation during the academic year 2019-20 and inspections were not conducted for the grant of continuation of provisional affiliation during 2020-21.

ii. The colleges whose first batch of all courses are passed out and no major deficiencies, but with minor deficiencies/no deficiencies were pointed out during inspection conducted for the grant of continuation of provisional affiliation during the academic year 2020-21.

iii. The colleges which will satisfy any of the above two conditions, if exempting the norm that the first batch of the students of all courses admitted in the college under EWS quota in various UG, PG courses and /or under super speciality courses(starting/enhancement of seats) were passed out.

3. Hence inspection is not required in the following Pharmacy colleges for the grant of Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the year 2021-22. The matter was placed before 63rd Governing Council and the GC vide decision cited (3), decided to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the colleges mentioned in the table below for conducting courses with annual intake



mentioned against each for the academic year 2021-22, subject to the receipt of renewal permission from PCI, without conducting inspection.

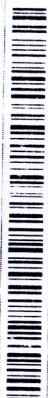
